Overledger 2.2.17

Overledger 2.2.17 enhances API support for Ethereum testnet Goerli (Görli) in anticipation of the retirement of Ropsten and Rinkeby testnets in the coming months.

As Ethereum transitions from a proof-of-work to a proof-of-stake blockchain as part of 'The Merge,' several existing testnets will be sunsetted. The Ropsten testnet, Ethereum's longest-lived proof-of-work testnet, will be shut down in Q4 2022. The Rinkeby testnet is also planned to be retired in 2023.

The Goerli testament has a strong community and infrastructure, and is well-suited for testing smart contract interactions. More information on 'The Merge' and the testnet infrastructure can be found on the The Ethereum Foundation Blog.

This release completes support for all available Ethereum-based functions for Goerli, including submitting transactions and using <u>no-code solution</u> to deploy secure, interoperable QRC-20 and QRC-721 digital tokens.
